

## OBITUARY

Death mercifully came to the relief of Mrs. Kinsey, wife of former Councilman Robert V. Kinsey, Saturday night. She had been ill with Bright's disease for two years, and although her suffering towards the last was severe, she bore the affliction with the patience that endeared her to a large circle of friends. Her maiden name was Miss Martha Lake, and she was born on Schooley's Mountain. She was 66 years old last November. Most of her married life was spent in Hackettstown, the last twenty years having been passed in the home in which she died. The husband and four children survive: Mrs. William Hefferman, of Easton; John S., Jerome E. and Frank H. Kinsey, all of Hackettstown. Two brothers and a sister also survive. They are Theodore Lake, of Cresco, Pa.; William Lake, of Philadelphia, and Mrs. William Tinsman, formerly of Port Murray, but now of Washington. Rev. Dr. Jackson conducted the funeral from the late home Wednesday afternoon, with interment in the family plot in Union Cemetery.
