

## Robert V. Kinsey

HACKETTSTOWN — Robert V. Kinsey, a former town councilman, died Thursday at Hackettstown Community Hospital after a short illness. He was 75.

Mr. Kinsey was born in Hackettstown and was a lifelong resident. He had worked for the Suburban Painting Co. here as a painter and paperhanger.

He was town fire chief in 1955 and 1956 and police commissioner in 1959. He was a member of the N.J. State Fire Chiefs Association, a life member of the N.J. Firemen's Relief Association and a life member of N.J. Exempt Firemen's Association.

He is survived by a brother, Ralph, Washington Borough, and two sisters, Marguerite Klie, Rutherford, and Marie Kattermann, Dover.
