

T. Robert Kitchen, ex-Hackettstown mayor

HACKETTSTOWN — Former councilman and Mayor T. Robert Kitchen died yesterday at Hackettstown Community Hospital after a short illness. He was 68.

He was born in Frenchtown and had lived in Hackettstown for 37 years. He was an Army veteran of World War II.



He had owned and operated the Hampton Coal and Lumber Co., Hampton, until 1977 when he retired and became a lumber salesman for the Warren Coal and Lumber Co., Washington. **DIED 1-6**

He was a former councilman and served as mayor of Hackettstown from 1964 to

1972. He was an exempt fireman with the Hampton Fire Department. He was a member of Bethlehem Lodge F&AM, Bloomsbury.

He was member of the Ancient Accepted Order of Scottish Rite Crescent Temple, Trenton. He was past president of the Hackettstown Rotary Club and was very active in Boy Scouting in town for many years.

He is survived by his wife, Ruth; a son, Thomas, Hackettstown; a daughter, Mrs. Linda Reese, Glen Gardner; and three grandchildren. **OR 1-7-1984**
