

OBITUARY

HOWARD KLOTZ, JR.

42, of 105 West Prospect Street died Wednesday, May 30, 1956, at 12:30 a. m. in Morristown Memorial Hospital, where he was admitted two days before. He had suffered from a heart condition for some time.

Mr. Klotz was the son of Howard and Mathilde Smith Klotz of the same address. His father is Hackettstown municipal clerk and tax collector. Born in Hackettstown on September 19, 1913, he spent his entire life here. Mr. Klotz was graduated from Hackettstown High School, Class of '31, and from Colgate University in 1935.

He was employed by the New Jersey Fish and Game Division at the Hackettstown Hatchery. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church.

In addition to his parents, he is survived by a sister, Margaret, at home.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon at the Cochran Funeral Home, followed by interment in Hackettstown Union Cemetery.
