GREAT MEADOWS — Funeral services were held Monday for Stephen Kowalick Sr., who helped found St. Nicholas Ukrainian Catholic Church in Great Meadows. Mr. Kowalick, 91, of Hope Road, died Friday at the Hackettstown Community Hospital, where he had been a patient since March 4.

Mr. Kowalick was born in Austria. He came to the United States in 1902, settling in the Pine Island, N.Y. area, and later moving to Great Meadows.

He was a retired farmer.

Last November, he and his wife, the former Frances Kowalczyk, celebrated their 69th wedding anniversary.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Kowalick is survived by two sons, Stephen Jr. and Michael of Great Meadows; two daughters, Miss Sophy Kowalick of Great Meadows

and Mrs. Estelle Maksymiuk of Forked River; five grandchildren; and 13 great-grandchildren.

Interment was in Pequest Union Cemetery in Great Meadows. The Scala Memorial Home, 124 High St., Hackettstown, handled the arrangements.
