Anthony "Tony" Kowalski III, 33, of White Township, died Dec. 6, 2009 at Morristown Memorial Hospital of injuries from a hit-and-run accident.

Born Dec. 18, 1975 in Hack-ettstown, he was a son of Antho-ny John Kowalski Jr. and Patricia Nash Kowalski of White Town-ship.

Mr. Kowalski lived in Great Meadows before moving to White Township nine years ago. He was a line operator for Mitsubishi Ka-gaku Imaging Corp. in Mansfield Township. A 1984 graduate of Warren Hills High School in Washington Township, Warren County, he received his Black Seal boiler operator certificate from Warren County Technical In-stitute in Franklin Township.

He was a member of Ss. Peter and Paul Roman Catholic Church in Great Meadows, where Mr. Kowalski was a former altar boy. He was a member of Our Lady of Hope Community in St. Augus-tine, Fla.

In addition to his parents, sur-viving are a brother, Michael of Hoboken; a sister, Michelle McIn-tosh of Hellertown, Pa.; a nephew, Brandon; and many aunts, uncles cousins and friends.

A funeral Mass was held Dec. 11 at Ss. Peter and Paul Church with Father Paul officiating. Inter-ment was in Pequest Union Cemetery, Great Meadows.
