Anna Rose Kristoff, 87, of Great Meadows, died Jan. 30, at Hackettstown Community Hospital.

Born Aug. 22, 1909 in Great Meadows, she was a daughter of the late Anthony and Sophie Rudinski. She lived in Pine Island, N.Y., before returning to Great Meadows.

Mrs. Kristoff and her late husband, Andrew, owned and operated Kristoff's Muck Farm in Great Meadows for many years and later a Christmas tree farm in Muncy, Pa.

She was a member of Sts. Peter and Paul Roman Catholic Church, Great Meadows; and a member of the Rosary Altar Society.

Her husband died May 14, 1983, after 51 years of marriage. A son, Edward, died in 1972. A granddaughter, Risa Kristoff, died earlier.

She is survived by three sons, Andrew of Raleigh, N.C., Larry of Great Meadows, and Robert, with whom she lived; three sisters, Mary Urevich of Great Meadows, Margaret Bogdanski of

Unionville, N.Y., and Frances Kucza of Pine Island, N.Y.; and 10 grandchildren.

Services were held in the Chapel of the Villa Madonna in Allamuchy. Burial was in Pequest Union Cemetery, Great Meadows. The Scala Memorial Home, Hackettstown, was in charge of arrangements.
