**THOMAS B. H. LaBAR
HACKETTSTOWN**

Funeral arrangements were incomplete at press time for Thomas B.H. LaBar, 75, of 308 Fifth Ave., who died Tuesday in Hackettstown Community Hospital.

Born in Camden, LaBar came to Hackettstown as a child. He was a graduate of Hackettstown High School and attended Lafayette College, Easton, Pa.

He retired in 1972 from the Somerset County engineer's office. He was a member of the state Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors. An Army veteran of World War II, he served as a major in the Corps of Engineers in the Aleutians and Okinawa. He was also a past master of Independence Lodge 42 F&AM, Hackettstown.

LaBar's father, the late C. Martin LaBar, was a mayor of Hackettstown.

He is survived by his widow, Elsie Beck LaBar.
