Mrs. Mary A. Lake.

Paralysis was the cause of the death of Mrs. Mary A. Lake, sixty-nine years old, Wednesday at the home of her son, George M. Lake on High street. She was the widow of Andrew N. Lake, who died about fourteen years ago. Mrs. Lake, whose maiden name was Minton, was a former resident of the vicinity of Chester, Morris County. The family came to Hackettstown in 1888. The only survivor is the son residing here. While a stroke of paralysis was the direct cause of the death of Mrs. Lake, she had been affected for sometime from Brights disease.

Funeral services will be held at two o'clock tomorrow afternoon at the home of her son on High street. Rev. W. R. Neff, pastor of Trinity M. E. Church, will officiate. Interment will be in the family plot in the Pleasant Hill Cemetery, Morris County.
