Howard Lambertson, 44, died of a heart attack Tuesday at the Grand avenue factory of the Lackawanna Leather Company, where he had been a boiler room attendant and watchman 10 years. He lived at Saxton Falls, where he moved three weeks ago from Park avenue, Hackettstown. He also resided near Mt. Bethel, Mansfield Township. Mr. Lambertson was born at Red Bank.
