

Miss Elizabeth Lamson.

Miss Elizabeth Lamson, daughter of Mrs. Sarah Lamson, of Church street, died in St. Barnebas Hospital, Newark, late yesterday afternoon after a temporary operation performed by Dr. Ill to relieve a stubborn intestinal obstruction. Her illness really began on Monday, and the suddenness of her death shocked a community which held her in the highest esteem. Dr. Smith was called in consultation with Dr. Osmun Wednesday night, and while the condition did not appear alarming, except to her physician, it was decided to take her to the hospital to-day. At five o'clock yesterday morning Dr. Osmun found the patient in an alarming condition and took her to Newark on the morning train. The heart action was very bad and an anæsthetic could not be administered. The temporary operation brought only temporary relief, and in the early evening word came of her death. She was thirty-one years of age, the picture of rugged womanhood, and a young woman of wide local popularity.
