

Louise Heath Leber

HACKETTSTOWN — Louise Heath Leber, 95, of Heath Village, died Sunday at the home, where she lived for 20 years. Before that, she lived in Hastings On Hudson, N.Y.

She was a former teacher at Friends School in Baltimore.

Born May 10, 1897, in Trenton, she was a daughter of the late Howard and Elizabeth Lawton Heath.

She was named Mother of the Year for New York State, and honored by Gov. Nelson Rockefeller in 1961. She served on the board of St. Christopher's School, and was director of the Presbyterian church nursery school for 10 years, both in Dobbs Ferry, N.Y. She served as president of the Resident's Council of Heath Village in 1978. She was a member of Panther Valley Ecumenical Ministry Church.

She graduated in 1920 from Sargent School of Physical Education in Boston.

She is survived by a daughter, Elizabeth Harther of Ponta Vedra Beach, Fla.; and two sons, Rev. Charles T. Jr. of Lakehurst, and Donald H. of Simsbury, Conn.

Services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday at the church. Burial will be in Loudon Park Memorial Cemetery in Baltimore. Arrangements are being handled by the Cochran Funeral Home in Hackettstown.
