

MICHAEL VINCENT LENDINO

65 years old, died unexpectedly Friday evening, March 24, 1944, at his home, 121 High Street, after an illness from a heart condition since last December. He was a real estate and insurance broker with an office in the Odd Fellows Building on Main Street.

A native of Italy, Mr. Lendino came to the United States at an early age, and has resided in Hackettstown for 34 years, prior to that living in New York City, Dover and Washington. He was a member of the Order of Odd Fellows, the Warren County Realty Board and the Veterans' Association, 13th Regiment, 245 Coast Artillery, New York National Guard.

Mr. Lendino is survived by his wife, Mrs. Otthine A. Lendino, one son, Vincent of Lafayette Street, Hackettstown; a daughter, Miss Marcella at home; a stepson, George L. Brown, chief petty officer of Davisville, R. I., and a brother, Frank, of Brooklyn.
