DAVID LOBL

Services were held Tuesday afternoon at the Katinis Funeral Chapel, Wilson, Pa., for David Lobl, 62, of 105 Deerfield Drive, Hackettstown, who died on Sunday, February 14, 1971, in Morristown Memorial Hospital. He had been in ill health for several years.

Mr. Lobl was an industrial consultant for the Teen Form Lingerie Manufacturing Co., Carlstadt. Before that he was employed by United Mills, Gilliam, N.C.

He was an internationally known boxing referee and formerly played soccer in Europe.

Born October 4, 1908, in Hungary, he was a son of the late Adolph and Bertha Wolf Lobl. He had lived in this country since 1945 and in Hackettstown the last 2½ years. He was a member of the West Jersey Jewish Community Center and Blackmere Lodge 127, F. & A. M., Mount Gilead, N. C.

Survivors include his wife, the former Sarah Sulkin; a daughter, Miss Ilona Beth Lobl of Summit, and a brother, Joseph of Flushing, L. I.

Interment was in Eaton (Pa.) Cemetery.
