

**WILLIAM LOERCH****HACKETTSTOWN**

Funeral services were held Tuesday for William Loerch, 94, of 303 Grand Ave., who died Saturday at Hackettstown Community Hospital after a long illness.

Born March 1, 1881 in Bedminster, he was a son of the late Godfried and Roxanne Loerch. He had lived in Washington before moving to Hackettstown in 1934.

He retired in 1950 as a signal maintainer for the Erie Lackawanna Railroad. He was assigned to the Hackettstown station.

He was a member of Local 680, Brotherhood of Railroad Signalmen of America.
