### DONALD H. LOMMASON

BANGOR, Pa. — Donald H. Lommason, formerly of Hackettstown, died July 26 at Easton Hospital in Easton, Pa., after a long illness. He was 82.

He was born Nov. 13, 1909, in Roxburg to the late E. Leo and Grace Dalrymple Lommason. He lived in the Hackettstown area for many years before moving to Bangor, Pa.

Mr. Lommason was the owner and operator of Leo's Luncheonette in Hackettstown for 35 years, retiring in 1980.
