PHILIP S. LONGCOR

Services were held this afternoon at the Cochran Funeral Home for Philip S. Longcor of Saxton Falls with Dr. Chester A. Pennington of Trinity Methodist Church officiating. Burial was in Hackettstown Union Cemetery.

Mr. Longcor, who was 83, died early Monday morning, June 25, 1951, while visiting friends at Parkesburg, Pa., in Chester County. His wife, Mrs. Bertha Luff Longcor, died 16 years ago.

A veteran of the Spanish American War, Mr. Longcor had been retired for five years. He was a carpenter for a number of years on railroad bridges and his last employment was at Stephens' State Park. Deceased was a member of the Canadian and Indian Lodge of Toronto.
