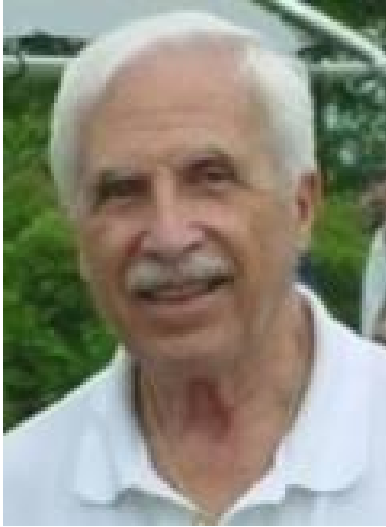


OBITUARY
