James B. Maddock Jr., 75, attorney in Washington, N.J., since 1934, died last night in Warren Hospital after a long illness. He lived at Dogwood Drive, Washington.

For many years he was the attorney for Franklin Township. He was a past president of the Warren County Bar Association and the Kiwanis Club of Washington. After being graduated from Lafayette College and before entering law school, he taught English in the Hampton schools.

Born in Phillipsburg on Oct. 18, 1902, he was a son of James B. Maddock Sr. and Lottie Sandt Maddock.

He received a bachelor of arts degree from Lafayette College in 1924 and was

graduated from the Rutgers Law School in 1934.

He was a member of the Lehigh Valley Alumni Club of Lafayette and the Rutgers Law School alumni association.

Mr. Maddock was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Washington, and Advocate Council 64, Sons and Daughters of Liberty, Washington.

After receiving a law degree, he was a clerk for the late William Stryker, Washington attorney.
