

Robert Maddox

Services were held Tuesday for Robert C. Maddox, 64, of Allamuchy, who died Friday in the Muhlenberg Regional Medical Center.

Born in Columbus, Ohio, Mr. Maddox lived in Plainfield before moving to Allamuchy. He served as mayor of Plainfield from 1963 to 1967.

He was a graduate of Washington and Lee University in Virginia, and was admitted to the New Jersey State Bar in 1951. He was assistant general counsel for the Prudential Insurance Company until his retirement in 1986.

Mr. Maddox was past president of the Plainfield and Union County Young Republican clubs, and received the Plainfield Young Man of the Year Award in 1960. He served as attorney for the Plainfield Planning Board and was a member of the Plainfield Council from 1959 to 1963.

He served in the Army during World War II and was a member of the American Legion post in Hackettstown, the Veterans of Foreign Wars post in Plainfield and the Association of Veterans of the Battle of the Bulge.

He is survived by his wife, Joanne; a son, John Storck; a daughter, Sandra Katz; and two grandchildren.
