Vera C. Magee, 97, of Spring Hill, Fla., died May 7, at Hernan-

do Pasco Hospice in Brooksville, Fla.

Born May 22, 1903 in Bayonne, she was a daughter of the late Martin and Florence Robein Cavanaugh.
