HACKETTSTOWN — Joseph T. Mahaffey, 41-107 Sunnyview Ave. East died Sunday at Saint Clare's Hospital in Denville after a brief illness. He was 58.

Born June 30, 1917 in Newark, Mr. Mahaffey was a son of Mrs. Rose Farrell Mahaffey of West Orange and the late Joseph Mahaffey.
