

**FORTUNATO V. MANNO  
HACKETTSTOWN**

Funeral services were held Tuesday for Fortunato (Ben) V. Manno, 50, of 205 East Baldwin St., who died Sunday at Morristown Memorial Hospital after a long illness.

Born March 25, 1927 in Buffalo, N.Y., he was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Vito Manno of Hackettstown.
