Private services were held for Charlotte R. Marks, 83, of Hackettstown, who died July 11 at Hackettstown Community Hospital.

She was born in Easton, Pa., and lived in Washington before moving to Hackettstown nine years ago.

She was employed as a telephone operator with Bell Atlantic in Easton, Pa., for 43 years, until her retirement in 1968.
