

## OBITUARY

The funeral services of Mrs. Lenora Gulick Marlatt will be held at half past three o'clock this afternoon in the First Presbyterian Church. She died suddenly Tuesday, May 14, 1918, at her home in Newark where she had resided for the past forty-seven years.

Her husband, James Marlatt, died six years ago, and an only daughter a few years before.

Mrs. Marlatt was born seventy-five years ago near Mount Bethel, but later lived with her parents, William and Seninah at the homestead farm now occupied by C. A. S. Gulick at the foot of the Schooleys Mountain, an only surviving brother. Burial will be made in Union Cemetery.
