

OBITUARY

Death came to Dr. Alden Edwards Martin last Thursday afternoon after an illness of short duration from complications attending old age. Had he lived a few days he would have reached his eighty-fifth milestone. Coming to Schooley's Mountain in the late summer of 1876 for his health he established himself there and remained for years when he moved to Hackettstown. He married Miss Catherine Adelia Carr, daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. John R. Carr on October 20, 1881. Dr. Martin had served the people of this vicinity continuously since he established his practice here. He had taken an active part in the civic affairs of the Town, having been elected Mayor and was vice-president to the Board of Health at time of his death. He was the oldest member of St. James Episcopal Church. Dr. Martin was a native of Peachan, Vt. He is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Ashon W. Davis, of California; Mrs. M. L. Fletcher and Mrs. J. Gilbert Stout of Hackettstown, and one son, J. Carr Martin, of Hackettstown.
