Nondas Mastrodimos

HACKETTSTOWN — Nondas

Mastrodimos, 66, died Wednesday, Oct. 22, in his home.

Born May 11, 1931, Thebes, Greece, he was a son of the late John and Vasiliki Mastrodimos. He lived in Netcong and then in Wharton before moving to Hackettstown in 1985.

He retired in 1994 after 26 years of service as a heavy equipment operator with Washington Township Road Department in Morris County.
