

OBITUARY

Frank Farley Mattison

55, died last evening, September 3, 1947, at Morristown Memorial Hospital where he was taken Tuesday afternoon in the American Legion ambulance following a severe heart attack. He had been ill at his residence in the Warren House, Hackettstown, for the past three months and had been on leave of absence from his employment at the Lackawanna Leather plant.

Mr. Mattison was a native of Washinton, born October 15, 1891, a son of the late William and Margaret Kishpaugh Mattison, but he had resided in Hackettstown since childhood. He leaves his wife, Mrs. Mabel Carpenter Mattison, two sons, Bernard and Harry; two grandchildren, a brother, Fred and a sister, Mrs Lulu Groover, all of Hackettstown.

Services will be held at his late residence at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon, conducted by the Rev. Andrew M. Sebben of the First Presbyterian Church. Burial will be in Hackettstown Union Cemetery under direction of Lloyd B. Cochran.
