

OBITUARY

William Axford Mattison, of 17 Duncan Avenue, Jersey City, accountant for the John S. Menagh Hardware Company and a direct descendant of John Hart, a signer of the Declaration of Independence, died Monday at his home, after an illness of three months. Death was due to a severe nervous breakdown brought about by too constant application to work. Mr. Mattison was born in Hackettstown, fifty six years ago. He went to Jersey City about thirty five years ago, since which time he was associated with Mr. Menagh. The deceased was a member of the Empire State Society of the Sons and Daughters of the Revolution, of Mt. Sinai Encampment and Iroquois Lodge, I.O.O.F. He was also an active member of St. John's P. E. Church. Surviving Mr. Mattison are his widow, Mrs. Alice Mattison, son, Evan Axford Mattison, a sister, Miss Ida Mattison, of Hackettstown, and a brother, Cyrus C. Mattison, of Chicago. Funeral services were conducted at the Mattison home yesterday afternoon by Rev. Worcester Perkins, pastor of St. John's Church.
