DAVID MCCLELLAN

David McClellan died early Monday morning after several months illness from Brights disease at his home on Main street.

Mr. McClellan was born near Mount Bethel seventy-four years ago. In early life he learned harness-making and for more than half a century he has conducted a harness store here.

At various times he has served as a member of the common council, Board of Water Commissioners and of the Board of Freeholders. He was a charter-member of the Improved Order of Red Men and Knights of Pythias and also a member of Independence Lodge F. and A. M. For many years he was a member of the official board of the M. E. church.

His widow who was Miss Frances McCracken, survives him with two sons, Dr. W. S. McClellan and Frank H. McClellan both of this place. Funeral services were held at his late home yesterday afternoon. Dr. Jackson officiated. Interment in the family plot in Union cemetery.
