Mrs. David McCellan.

Mrs. Fannie McClellan, widow of David McClellan, died late last Saturday (February 12, 1916) night at her home on Main Street after a week's illness from pneumonia and a weak heart, following an attack of grip. Her husband died about two years ago, and she was the last surviving heir of the late James McCracken.

Mrs. McClellan was born near Blairstown seventy-one years ago, but for more than fifty years had been a resident here. She had resided in the home in which she died for the past forty years. She is survived by two sons, Dr. W. S. McClellan and Frank H. McClellan, both of this place. Funeral services were held at her late home Wednesday afternoon, and were conducted by Dr. Jackson, pastor of Trinity M. E. church, of which Mrs. McClellan had been a member many years. Interment was in the family plot in Union Cemetery.
