Mrs. Julia W. McCracken, nee Miss Julia Howell, aged sixty-two years, passed away unexpectedly at her home in Morristown on Tuesday afternoon after having been discharged from Dr. Mills' Hospital, where she underwent an operation and was considered out of danger, but complications set in that effected the heart and death followed very suddenly.

Mrs. McCracken was one of a large family, having had seven brothers and sisters, who all resided in Hackettstown.

After her marriage to William McCracken, who was one of the town boys, they made their home in Morristown for a number of years where he is employed on the tax board.
