Death of Miss Linda D. McCracken.

Miss Linda D. McCracken, aged 57 years and 5 months, died after a brief illness from pleuro-pneumonia, last Friday afternoon, at her home on Washington Street. The disease developed about a week previous to death and her weak constitution readily succumbed to the fatalities characteristic of h e r sickness.

The deceased was the daughter of the late James McCracken. For many years she was engaged in school teaching, but for the past six years has been managing Mrs. Dikeman's house on Washington Street. In early life she accepted the Methodist confession of faith and her life was one of conscientious Christian submission. Her generosity and hospitality was best known to those with whom she was constantly associated and intimately acquainted.

She is survived by one sister, Mrs. David McClellan. Funeral services were conducted by her pastor, Rev. C. X. Hutchinson, at her late residence Monday afternoon. Interment in the family plot in Union cemetery.
