Funeral services will be held at 10:15 a.m. today for James M. McDonald, 57, of 23 Laurie Terr., who died Monday night at Morristown Memorial Hospital.

A member of the Army's 82nd Airborne Division during World War II, he was recipient of numerous medals including the Purple Heart, the Distinguished Unit Badge and the E.A.M.E. ribbon with one bronze battle star.

Born in Philadelphia, he lived in the Madison and Morristown area before moving to Hackettstown 10 years ago. He was a retired operating room orderly at Morristown Memorial.
