William G. McDonald.

William G. McDonald died October 4th, at his home in Freeport, N. Y. Mr. McDonald was a former resident of Hackettstown, being the son of Mr. and Mrs. James J. McDonald of Jefferson street.

He was 32 years of age, and was one of seven sons who graduated from Hackettstown High School, being in the class of 1920. A sister, Anna, also graduated from this school.

After leaving Hackettstown he completed his studies at New York University, graduating with degrees LLB. and CPA. He practiced law in New York City for a while, but for the past three years has been located at Del Rio, Texas, on the Mexican border, where he was building up a very fine practice.

He came north about a month ago on a visit to his family, and while here he suffered a severe heart attack from which he did not recover. He was buried in Holy Rood Cemetery, Westbury, L. I. He is survived by his parents, two sisters, Sadie and Anna, of Freeport, and seven brothers, James J., of Northport, L. I.; Frank D., Edward C., of Brooklyn; Joseph, Charles, Leo, of Freeport, and Thomas A., of Atlantic Beach, L. I.
