
## OBITUARY

HACKETTSTOWN — William J. McDonald, 69, of Lawrence Drive, a town councilman for two terms from 1976 to 1983, died Monday in Hackettstown Community Hospital.

He was also a former member of the Hackettstown Planning Board, Zoning Board and Board

of Adjustments.

He was employed as facilities services manager at Allied Signal in Morris Township before retiring in 1979.
