Andrew W. McLean

Andrew Wack McLean died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. C. V. S. Rea, on Washington Street last Sunday morning after an illness of less than two weeks. Deceased was in the 70th year of his age, and for nearly forty years has been a resident of Hackettstown, and for some years was an important factor in the business activities of the community. He came to Hackettstown from Drakestown and with his brother, Amos McLean, engaged in the carriage manufacturing business on a large scale. He was universally regarded in the community as a man of the strictest integrity, reserved in his personal intercourse but meeting every duty and responsibility of citizenship. He is survived by three sons and his daughter Mrs. Rea. The funeral services were held on Wednesday, Rev. Mr. Johnson of the Methodist Church, of which deceased was a member, officiating. The interment was in Union Cemetery.
