HACKETTSTOWN — Floyd W. McNeel of Grand Avenue, Hackettstown, died yesterday in Chapelhill, Pa., while visiting relatives. He was 67. *DIED 1-2*

Born in Hackettstown, Mr. McNeel lived most of life here. He was a civil engineer employed by Centenary College, Hackettstown, for 18 years as director and plant engineer. He retired in 1981.



Mr. McNeel was a 1937 graduate of Hackettstown High School and was an Army veteran of World War II.

He was a member of Trinity Methodist Church, Hackettstown, where he was past chairman of the administrative board and vice president of the board of trustees.

He was also past chairman of the Hackettstown board of adjustment; past member of the Warren County Industrial Board; past president and charter member of the Hackettstown Lions Club; and a member of the Ancient Accepted Order of Scottish Rite, Valley of the Northeast, Livingston; Independence Lodge No. 42, FA&M, Hackettstown, and the Hackettstown Historical Society.

He is survived by his wife, Alice; a son, David, Easton, Pa.; a daughter, Susan, New Hope, Pa.; a brother, Ralph, Saxton Falls; and four grandchildren. *DA 1-3-1984*
