

Charles McPeak; 24 years on school board

MOUNT OLIVE TWP. — Charles E. McPeak, who served on the board of education here for 24 years, died suddenly Monday at the home of his daughter, Dorothy Murray, in Flanders.

Born in Drakestown where he had lived most of his life, Mr. McPeak moved to Mountain Road here four years ago.

A retired dairy farmer, Mr. McPeak served on the board of education from 1930-1954 and was the board's president from 1941-1954.

Mr. McPeak was a deacon and trustee of the Mount Olive Baptist Church, here.

He was a committeeman for the Agway Corp. in Syracuse, N.Y.
