Eileen H. Mial, 60, of 117 High St., Hackettstown, died Monday in her home after a long illness.

Born July 22, 1923, in Paterson, N.J., she was a daughter of the late Russell and Sadie Hall Har-difer. She lived in Hackettstown since 1950.

A 1946 graduate of Cornell University, she was a former member of the Hackettstown Library Board and served on the Hackettstown Board of Education.
