Dr. John P. Mial, O.D., 72, of Blairstown died March 15 at Chipsa Hospital, Tijuana Beach, Mexico.

Dr. Mial was born March 2, 1924 in Paterson. He lived in Blairstown for many years.

He was an Optometrist, practicing in Hackettstown since 1952.
