

## **Anthony Eugene Michniewicz**

Anthony Eugene Michniewicz, also known as Meeker, 86, of Stroudsburg, Pa., died June 18 at Pocono Medical Center in Stroudsburg, after a long illness.

Born in Great Meadows, he resided most of his life in Hackettstown and since 1984 Stroudsburg.

He retired as a machine and tool maker for Thiokol Chemical in Rockaway, in 1978 after 20 years of service.
