HACKETTSTOWN — Kandice J. Michniewicz, a Hackettstown High School teacher, died yesterday at Hackettstown Community Hospital. She was 31.

Mrs. Michniewicz was a math teacher at Hackettstown High School, where she also served as the high school's band front adviser and, for the last four years, the senior class trip advisor.

Born in New Brunswick, she lived most of her life in Hackettstown.

She was a member of the Trinity United Methodist Church, Hackettstown; the New Jersey Education Association; the Hackettstown Education Association; and the National Education Association.

A 1972 graduate of Hackettstown High School, she received a bachelor's degree in secondary math education from Glassboro State College in 1976. She recently received a master's degree at East Stroudsburg (Pa.) State College for secondary education administration.
