

Funeral services for Edgar W. Miller Jr., 48, of 100 Old Allamuchy Road, Hackettstown, who died on Friday, August 11, 1972, after a short illness at the home of his brother, James of Morris Plains.

The service at the Cochran Funeral Home in Hackettstown was followed by a Mass of the Resurrection at St. Mary's Church of the Assumption, where he was a member. Knights of Columbus rites were held Saturday at the funeral home. Burial was in the Pequest Union Cemetery, Great Meadows.
