Frank A. Mingle, 73, Essex Fells mayor

Frank A. Mingle, 73, of Essex Fells, who served as mayor of the community from 1982 until last January, died yesterday in Mountain-side Hospital, Glen Ridge.

Services will be offered at 10 a.m. Tuesday in St. Peter's Episcopal Church, Essex Fells. Arrangements are by the Dancy Funeral Home, Caldwell.

Mr. Mingle was elected mayor of Essex Fells in 1981 and served until retiring nine months ago.

He formerly was president of the Motors Insurance Corp., a subsidiary of the General Motors Acceptance Corp., in New York City, where he worked from 1934 until his retirement in 1977.

Mr. Mingle was a member of the executive committee of GMAC and was a member of the board of directors of the Jonathan Logan Corp. in

New York City.

He was active in the United Fund of New York City and Essex Fells. He was a member and served as president in 1976 of the Essex Fells Country Club.

Mr. Mingle also was a member of the Seaview Country Club in Absecon and the Skytop Club in Pocono, Pa.

Born in Newark, he lived most of his life in Essex Fells.

Surviving are his wife, Mae; a son, Larry; a daughter, Miss Maureen; a sister, Mrs. Elisabeth Stober, and three grandchildren.
