IN SHERBORN, MASS.

Mrs. A. H. C. Mitchell passed away Sunday at her home on Washington street, Sherborn, Mass., where she has resided for a number of years. Mrs. Mitchell was born in Hackettstown in 1869, and is survived by two sisters, Mrs. Laura Hann of Liberty street and Mrs. George Pool of Great Meadows, and three brothers, all residing in New Jersey. (She was a second cousin of Sir Ernest Shackleton of England.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Dec. 18, at her late residence in Sherborn, Mass. She was a great lover of flowers and animals, was one of the first to become interested in the breeding of silver foxes in this country.
