Henry J. Monetti

Henry J. Monetti, 80, of Great Meadows, died Sept. 30, at Warren Hospital in Phillipsburg after a long illness.

Born Oct. 23, 1919 in Newark, he was the son of the late Luigi and Rose Leone Monetti.
