

LAMBETH MONTFORT

HACKETTSTOWN — Funeral services will be held this afternoon (Wednesday) in the First Presbyterian Church, Hackettstown, for Lambeth R. Montfort, 66, Petersburg Road, Hackettstown, an Independence Township committeeman, who died Sunday in the Morristown Memorial Hospital, where he was a patient since July 7.

Born in Hamilton, he lived in Morristown for many years before moving to Hackettstown six years ago. He was serving his first term as township committeeman.

Mr. Montfort retired four years ago as head of the transmission engineering department of Bell Labs, Murray Hill Division.

He was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Hackettstown; Hope and Warren County Historical societies, Frank B. Jewett Chapter, Telephone Pioneers of America, and the Institute for Electrical Engineers.

Survivors include his widow, the former Helen Gellespie; two sons, Edward D., Bowie, Md., and William C., Long Valley, N.J.; a daughter, Miss Nancy L. Montfort, Ann Arbor, Mich., and three grandchildren.
