

JOHN R. MOONEY

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon for John R. Mooney at his late home, 516 Grand Avenue, with the Rev. Alvin A. Jones, pastor of Trinity Methodist Church, officiating. Interment was in Hackettstown Union Cemetery.

Mr. Mooney, a retired employe of the Lackawanna Railroad Company, died Wednesday, September 13, 1944, at his home at the age of 71. He was a native of Mount Olive Township, but was a resident of Hackettstown the greater part of his life. Mr. Mooney held employment with the railroad for 47 years, serving a greater part of the time as section foreman on the Morris and Essex division at Hackettstown. He retired

six years ago.

Mr. Mooney is survived by his wife, Susanna C. Mooney; a son, Clayton Mooney of Hackettstown; a brother, George Mooney of Andover, and a sister, Mrs. Albert Hummer of Hackettstown. Deceased held membership in Independence Lodge No. 42, F. and A. M., since 1929.
