HACKETTSTOWN — Funeral services will be held tomorrow for William E. Nagle Jr., 27, of 82 Alexandria Drive, who was killed in Friday's mass murder.

Born in Franklin, he had lived in Vernon Township all his life until moving to Hackettstown one month ago. He was employed as a supervisor for the Warren County Mosquito Commission. He was graduated from Franklin High School in 1968. He had also attended Up-sala College and was a member of the Vernon Methodist Church.

He also was a member of the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association.

He is survived by his wife, Cheryle; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. William Nagle Sr. of Vernon, and his paternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Charles E. Nagle of Vernon.

The 11 a.m. service will be at the F. John Ramsey Funeral Home, 1 Main St., Franklin. Rev. Gary Schroeder of the Vernon Lutheran Church will officiate. Burial will be in North Hardyston Cemetery. Visiting hours today are 2 to 4, 7 to 9 p.m.
